## INDIVIDUAL PLAY

### Passport Prize Lottery Drawings

Each participant can earn 1 entry per into the prize drawings by submitting a Central Ohio Bike Month Passport with at least 3 activities completed. Passports can be submitted via email to [gohio@morpc.org](mailto:gohio@morpc.org) or mailed to the address below. Participants may earn a maximum 1 entry per designated age group. Ages and a must be listed on the passport or with the passport in either form of submission. An email or phone number must also be listed so participants can be contacted if they win a prize.

There is a limit of one passport submission per individual. Contest is not open to MORPC, COTA, Smart Columbus, or CoGo employees, Lyft employees, Commute by Enterprise employees, MORPC board members or their immediate families.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

Participants who are physically unable mail or email in their passports are welcome to phone in their August bike activities and claim their prizes over the phone (380) 235-275. MORPC staff will ensure the diverse populations of Central Ohio may participate in People Who Bike.
